

Angel Fund Allocation Procedure

Funds donated to the District Angel Fund will be utilized in the order outlined below. As much as possible, the District will spend money donated to the Fund during the school year in which it was donated. Any funds donated from graduating seniors' positive meal accounts will be utilized the following school year.

1. Attempt to follow the wishes of the donor. Example: unpaid balances for certain school, certain family, certain grade, etc.
2. Pay off meal debt from individuals who have been identified as homeless
3. Pay off meal debt from families who are requesting help due to temporary financial difficulties
4. Pay off meal debt from families who were approved for free or reduced-priced meals
5. Work with school social workers and administrators to identify students with significant needs and pay off meal debt. Preference will be given to families who have applied for free/reduced-priced meals, but were denied
6. If there are funds left over, the money is prorated among all remaining negative balances over -\$150.00

How Contributions Will Be Allocated:

- \$ 100 - \$ 250 Split between 5 families
- \$ 251 - \$ 500 Split between 10 families
- \$ 501 - \$ 750 Split between 15 families
- \$ 751 - \$1000 Split between 20 families
- Over \$1000 Split between 25 families
