Keep Up To Date on All Schedules

Our activities schedules are Online! Visit our school website - isd743.org, select Activities – Activities Calendar.

If you would like to be notified of changes that occur on the schedule, click Notify Me! on the top right of the screen. Then click Notify Me in the menu on the right. Select all activities you want to be automatically notified with changes and then follow the on screen prompts to finish setup.

Activities Registration Online Has Been Implemented!

You must go Online to register for activities, fill out MSHSL information and enter health information. This has been a popular change – no more paperwork. Go to isd743.org and select Activities. You can register for all activities you intend to participate in at the same time.

All student athletes must take care of three things before they will be allowed to practice:

- 1) Must have a current physical on file in the office updated every 3 years.
- 2) Must complete the Online registration process.
- 3) Must pay the participation fee.

When paying for your activities you may pay Online or bring a check/cash in to the Activities Office. You don't have to pay for all activities for the year -- just the one that is in season.

Activities Office Use Instant Alert to Notify Parents of Cancellations

We use the Instant Alert system for parents of athletes. Using this system, you receive a recorded phone message about any game cancellations. We normally make these decisions based on weather at 2 p.m. and do the phone call

at that time. We encourage all parents to make sure your data is up to date on the Instant Alert system to take full advantage of this program. Students involved in our sports teams are already placed on lists, depending on what sports they are involved with each season.

Headstrong Concussion Insurance Program Offered by MSHSL

The Minnesota State High School League provides all its member schools and their students with a free Concussion Insurance Program which is specifically developed to insure student participants from the high cost of concussion treatment and neurological follow-up. The injury must be sustained while the student is participating in an MSHSL covered event. All students are eligible for coverage in grades 7 through 12, participating in activities, practice or play of sports, at the varsity, junior varsity, b-squad, and sophomore level sponsored by the MSHSL. The policy limit is \$25,000 per injury medical maximum. Coverage is secondary/excess to any other valid and collectible insurance carried by the parent/guardian. More information will be available through the MSHSL by September 1, or you can contact Scott Bergman in the AD Office.
